print run sold out quickly. Alice
was a publishing sensation,
beloved by children and adults
alike. Among its first avid readers
were Queen Victoria and the
young Oscar Wilde. The book has
never been out of print. Alice's
Adventures in Wonderland has
been translated into at least 174
languages. There have now been
over a hundred English-language
editions of the book, as well as
countless adaptations in other
media, especially theatre and

film.
