In this book he convincingly shows that an irreducible minimum of experience underlies the New Testament account of

the resurrection, however much of the details of the narrative may be open to objection. He maintains that life after death is part of the Jewish faith experience, and that it is Jesus' messiahship, not his resurrection, which marks the division between Christianity and Judaism.
