 utility of a thing
 makes it a use-
 value.¹³ But this
 utility is not a thing
 of air. Being limited
 by the physical
 properties of the
 commodity, it has
 no existence apart
 from that
 commodity. A
 commodity, such as
 iron, corn, or a

diamond, is therefore, so far as it is a material thing, a use-value, something useful. This property of a commodity is independent of the amount of labour required to appropriate its useful qualities. When treating of use-value, we always assume to be dealing with definite quantities, such as dozens of watches, yards of linen, or tons of iron. The use-values of commodities furnish the material for a special study, that of the commercial knowledge of commodities.¹⁴ Use-values become a reality only by use or consumption:

they also constitute the substance of all wealth, whatever may be the social form of that wealth.
