La stéréotypie affecte ainsi durablement la vie des sociétés sur plusieurs niveaux : elle crée des stéréotypes sociaux, construit des catégories, conçoit des modèles (ou des anti-modèles) pour susciter des comportements et des modes de pensée, travail auquel les élites prennent une part active ; elle trace des images fortement dessinées (parce que répétées) des différents éléments qui constituent l'outillage intellectuel des peuples ; elle établit les représentations de la différence, en façonnant des clichés identitaires. La construction des stéréotypes intéresse donc les historiens. Ce sont des outils pour construire du sens, pour classer, organiser, une manière, comme le conseillait Buffon, d'accumuler des faits pour avoir des idées. Une manière aussi de figer les représentations sur l'Autre, le Différent, ce grand acteur de l'histoire.

This stream is known today as dependency grammar (DG). Drawing examples from dozens of languages, many of which he was proficient in,

Tesnière presents insightful analyses of numerous phenomena of syntax. Among the highlights are the concepts of valency and head-initial vs. head-final languages. These concepts are now taken for granted by most modern theories of syntax, even by phrase structure grammars, which represent, in a sense, the opposite sort of approach to syntax from what Tesnière was advocating. Set across four decades, this trilogy follows the rise of the dashing D'Artagnan—from hot-headed soldier to trusted captain under Louis XIV. Dumas' other novels include "The Count of Monte Cristo" and "The Black Tulip". His works have been adapted into more than 200 movies, including *The Man in the Iron Mask* starring Leonardo DiCaprio.
