Os materiais microfilmados sob o signo da BPG encontram-se hoje espalhados por mais de 30 bibliotecas dos Estados Unidos, além de instituições de memória e pesquisa da Europa e do Brasil — entre elas a Biblioteca Nacional. Para trazer à tona as narrativas que se entrelaçam na curiosa história dessa coleção, a abordagem parte de sua relação com os diferentes contextos políticos norte-americanos e brasileiros, atentando para distintas temporalidades e subjetividades que marcaram sua produção, bem como sua circulação. A presente obra ilumina, assim, o percurso histórico da BPG, dando visibilidade à construção narrativa de seu colecionador e a alguns dos significados e lugares que foram atribuídos a essa coleção ao longo de sua existência. O texto destaca-se por permitir ao público adentrar no universo das coleções com dimensão pública e compreender os diversos interesses sociopolíticos que envolvem e permitem a constituição de tais coleções bem como os lugares que ocupam na sociedade.
